The charge of the committee is to:

- 1. Establish appropriate general guidance for the orderly development and presentation of the campus.
- 2. Provide input to proponents/designers of proposed projects contributing to development of the campus.
- 3. Provide reaction to specific design/development solutions proposed by contracted professionals and in-house staff.

In addition to the foregoing charge, the CDAC will be asked to provide comments relative to design concepts, historical sites and art in public spaces.
