Dear Colleagues,

I am asking you to serve as a member of the Public Safety Advisory Committee (PSAC) for the 2023-2024 year. Brian Brauer, Executive Director of Emergency Management, has agreed to chair this committee and John Marquardt, Director of State Farm Center, will serve as vice-chair.

The PSAC is established for the purpose of serving as an official advisory committee at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign. - 3. offer advice relevant to crime and fear abatement, law enforcement, public safety, and emergency preparedness;
- 4. actively support measures that enhance the foundation of safety and security on which the university was established; and
- 5. empower the public in the spirit of community-oriented public safety to assist the University of Illinois Division of Public Safety in their endeavor to better serve the campus community.
